Special Board Meeting
Via Zoom
Minutes

Mayor Kenneth Talton called the meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. Those in attendance per roll call of Mayor Kenneth Talton were Mayor Pro-Tempore Steve Wiggins, Commissioner Vicky Darden, Commissioner Harlie Carmichael, Commissioner Barbara Kornegay, Commissioner Dennis Draper, Town Manager Jammie Royall and Town Clerk/Administrative Assistant Sherry Davis and Town Attorney Carroll Turner.

Mayor Kenneth Talton welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Commissioner Dennis Draper delivered our invocation and Mayor Kenneth Talton led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Kenneth Talton read the Conflict of Interest Statement; there were no conflicts.

Mayor Kenneth Talton requested a motion to approve the published agenda Commissioner Dennis Draper made the motion. Commissioner Harlie Carmichael seconded and the motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Kenneth Talton requested a motion to approve the published agenda as amended. Commissioner Barbara Kornegay made the motion.

Mayor Kenneth Talton then discussed Non-Action Memo – 01-06 – Consider Adoption of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Headworks Short Term Monitoring Plan as required by our Special Order of Consent.

Mayor Kenneth Talton asked Waste Water Treatment Plant ORC Glenn Holland to explain this program. Waste Water Treatment Plant ORC Glenn Holland advised that we currently have no active program to limit Industry Permit Program issued to any industrial user. Basically, it gives us the authority to fine industrial users.

Commissioner Barbara Kornegay asked if the state has approved this Short Term Monitoring Plan. Waste Water Treatment Plant ORC Glenn Holland advised that state has already approved it. We are required to have this plan in place by March or April of 2022. He said each industrial user must provide a full analysis of chemical levels annually or every three years. We will have the option to make any industrial user retest if we feel it is necessary.

Commissioner Barbara Kornegay asked if this is a one- time test and if this drawing was already in place. Waste Water Treatment Plant ORC Glenn Holland answered yes it is a one-time test. He advised the drawing is just a generic drawing of the Waste Water Treatment Plant. Commissioner Barbara Kornegay wanted to know if this drawing is the process of what happens at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. Waste Water Treatment Plant ORC Glenn Holland said, yes. He advised an outside contractor was hired to write this program so there would be no appearance of Conflict of Interest.

Mayor Kenneth Talton asked if there are any other questions regarding the Waste Water Treatment Plant Headworks Short Term Monitoring Plan.

Mayor Kenneth Talton asked for a motion to approve. Commissioner Barbara Kornegay made a motion to accept the Waste Water Treatment Plant Headworks Short Term Monitoring Plan as presented. Mayor Pro-Tempore Steve Wiggins seconded the motion. Mayor Kenneth Talton asked each Board Member individually for a yay or nay. Mayor Pro-Tempore Steve Wiggins is a yay, Commissioner Vicky Darden is a yay, Commissioner Harlie Carmichael is a yay, Commissioner Barbara Kornegay is a yay and Commissioner Dennis Draper is a yay. The motion passed 5-0.

There being no further business Commissioner Dennis Draper made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Vicky Darden seconded and the motion passed 5-0.
